Alleluia, alleluia!


Tomorrow the wickedness of the earth will be destroyed: the Saviour of the world will be our king.

# THE HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS, MARY AND JOSEPH Feast Day 30<sup>th</sup> December

# ST. STEPHEN, THE FIRST MARTYR Feast day 26<sup>th</sup> December

St. Stephen is a recognized saint in many Christian theologies, and is considered to be the first Christian

martyr.

According to the Acts of the Apostles, Stephen was denounced

for blasphemy after a dispute with members of a Jewish synagogue circa the year 36. He was condemned and stoned to death.

# THE HOLY INNOCENTS Feast Day 28th December

Matthew 2:1-18 tells this story: Herod was "greatly troubled" when astrologers from the east came asking the whereabouts of "the newborn king of the Jews," whose star they had seen.

They were told that the Jewish Scriptures named Bethlehem as the place where the Messiah would be born. Herod cunningly told them to report back to him so that he could also "do him homage." They found

Jesus, offered him their gifts and, warned by an angel, avoided Herod on their way home. Jesus escaped to Egypt.



Herod became furious and "ordered the massacre of all the boys in Bethlehem and its vicinity two years old and under."

# ST. JOHN, APPOSTLE AND EVANGELIST Feast Day 27<sup>th</sup> December

St. John, the Evangelist, who is styled in



the Gospel, "the beloved disciple", was a Galilean, son of Zebedee and Salome, and brother to St.
James the Greater, both of whom were fishermen.
The two were called by Jesus to be disciples as they were mending their

nets by the Sea of Galilee.

St. John was the only one of the Apostles who did not forsake the Saviour in the hour of His Passion and Death.

St. John wrote his Gospel after the other Evangelists, about sixty-three years after the Ascension of Christ; also three Epistles, and the wonderful and mysterious Book of the Apocalypse or Revelation
